# LEMON LAW FAQ'S

## **Q: DOES THE CALIFORNIA LEMON LAW APPLY TO MY VEHICLE?**

A: The CA Lemon Law applies to vehicles that have been repeatedly repaired for the same or similar problem while under warranty. Vehicles include:

- Cars, pickup trucks, vans, and SUVs
- ATVS, motorcycles, boats, and RVs
- Leased vehicles

## **Q: WHAT CAN I RECEIVE IF MY VEHICLE IS A LEMON?**

If your vehicle is a lemon, you could qualify for a Refund, Replacement Vehicle, or Cash Compensation. A refund consists of the reimbursement of all monies spent on your vehicle including your down payment, monthly payments, taxes, incidental expenses related to the lemon, and your attorneys fees and costs.

## **Q: WHICH VEHICLE PROBLEMS ARE COVERED BY THE LEMON LAW?**

A: Any vehicle complaint that reduces its safety, use or value. These complaints range and cover most vehicle systems including but not limited to the engine, transmission, electrical, steering, and more.

## **Q: DO I STILL HAVE A CLAIM IF MY VEHICLE IS OUT OF WARRANTY?**

A: If the first repair attempt occurred during the warranty period, then you may still have a claim.

# IS MY VEHICLE A LEMON?

In the State of California, your vehicle is legally presumed to be a lemon if during the first 18 months or 18,000 miles, any of the following scenarios occur:

- The vehicle is repaired at least two times for a safety defect that can cause injury or death; or
- The vehicle is repaired at least four times for non-substantial defect; or
- The vehicle spends at least 30 calendar days out of service due to repairs

Note that the lemon law presumption is NOT necessary to have a valid lemon law claim. Rather, if your vehicle has been repaired repeatedly during your vehicle's applicable limited or powertrain warranties, it may be a lemon.
